REFLECTIONS CITY BREAKFAST

A focused morning gathering held each September, bringing together sponsors, supporters, and invited City voices for conversation, continuity, and civic insight.

Understanding the Investment

We believe in clarity and stewardship. A typical allocation of the £5,500 includes:

Ten Gala Evening places	£2,050
Two Breakfast places	£150
Roundel production and prize support	£1,000
Event production, coordination and delivery	£675
Filming and digital storytelling	£500
Programme design, printing and sponsor visibility	£300
Participant creative pathway delivery*	£825
Total	£5,500

*May include artist-led engagement, workshops, demonstrations, storytelling activity or participant materials, where appropriate.

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These figures are indicative and may vary slightly depending on venue, production, participation and delivery requirements.

Beyond the evening itself, sponsorship helps sustain a wider framework of youth engagement, creative commissioning, civic storytelling, accessibility, and public-facing educational activity connected to Reflections of The Lord Mayor and the wider ethos of Striving for Excellence in Our Work.

This ensures the programme remains both high-quality and accessible.

Recognising Achievement – Shared Value

At the heart of each Roundel Stream is a simple but meaningful model of recognition.

For youth-focused streams

- ✓ £100 awarded to the individual winning participant
- ✓ £100 awarded to their school, unit, sett, or participating organisation

Since 2018, these awards have been presented in a form that encourages young people to begin their own savings journey, often with the support of their parents or guardians.

For the Circle of Comfort

Where the work is created collectively, recognition is shaped in a way that reflects the nature of the group and the setting — directed towards the shared piece and the community involved in its creation.

This approach ensures that:

- Achievement is recognised in a way that is appropriate to each context
- Contribution is collectively supported where work is shared
- The wider community shares in success

Beyond creation, each stream leads to a moment of recognition.

Participation in the Roundel Streams culminates in a special moment at the Gala Evening.

Where appropriate, the winning young person is invited to attend the presentation ceremony during the reception, accompanied by their parents and a teacher, unit, or sett leader, to celebrate their achievement together.

For the Circle of Comfort, participants involved in the creation of the collective piece may be invited to attend the presentation during the reception, alongside members of the hospice team, to share in the moment of recognition.

For many, this is more than an award. It is:

- a moment of recognition in a civic setting
- an opportunity to feel a sense of belonging
- an experience that encourages aspiration and confidence

Your support helps make these moments possible — not only through the creation of the work itself, but through the opportunity to share it, celebrate it, and be recognised for it.

Understanding the Investment

We believe in clarity and stewardship, particularly for partners supporting the programme at scale.

Supporting all five streams individually represents a total programme value of:

5 streams × £5,500 = £27,500

The Youth & Community Streams Partner is offered at **£20,000**, reflecting a consolidated commitment across the full programme.

How this support is directed

As with individual streams, the partnership contributes to:

Participant engagement across all five streams

Roundel production and prize support

Creative delivery, including workshops, materials, and facilitation

Digital storytelling, filming, and programme visibility
